WHAT IS AN ETHNOGRAPHY?

- THERE ARE MANY WAYS TO DO ETHNOGRAPHY BASED ON A RESEARCHERS PARADIGM AND THEORETICAL STANDPOINT
- HOWEVER ALL FORMS OF ETHNOGRAPHY CAN BE CHARACTERIZED USING 4 CENTRAL ASPECTS:
 - FIRST HAND EXAMINATION OF A SOCIAL AND/OR CULTURAL SETTING
 - RESEARCHERS IMMERSION IN THIS SETTING
 - INDUCTIVE & SYSTEMATIC APPROACH TO ANALYSIS
 - A DETAILED AND ORGANIZED REPORT OF FINDINGS

FIELD NOTES

Jot

Quick writings of words, sensory details, happenings, recall help, in the moment

Describe

Detailed writings, full situations, fleshed out sensory information, "objective"

Analyze

Writing to understand, possible conclusions, discussions and connections

Reflect

Personal, reflexive, thoughts, feelings, and emotions, processing, accountability, checking assumptions

PROS CONS

- EXTREMELY DETAILED
- COMMUNITY CENTERED
- CAN SPEAK TO COMPLEXITY
- BETTER COMMUNITY
 PROCESSES
- BUILD STRONGER
 CONNECTIONS
- HIGHER CHANCE OF ACTION

- TIME CONSUMING
- EXPENSIVE
- DIFFICULT TO DO FOR MANY REASONS
- BECOMING "OVER" INVOLVED IN THE COMMUNITY
- POTENTIAL TROUBLE OF PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS
